



MariaDB Software License Terms

These MariaDB Software License Terms (“**Terms**”) govern Customer’s use of the MariaDB software, including updates and new versions (the “**Software**”), and its written technical information (“**Documentation**”), provided by MariaDB USA, Inc. or its affiliates (“**MariaDB**”). Using the Software or Documentation constitutes agreement to these Terms. These Terms supplement any written agreement or order form between MariaDB and Customer (the “**Agreement**”). If no Agreement or active subscription exists, the MariaDB Subscription Agreement (<https://mariadb.com/terms/>) serves as the Agreement and the Customer is identified in the MariaDB ID. Unless specified otherwise, capitalized terms have the meanings assigned in the Agreement.

1. **License Grant.** Subject to Customer’s payment of applicable fees under the Agreement, MariaDB grants Customer a personal, limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, worldwide, and revocable license, without the right to sublicense, to use the Software for Customer’s internal business purposes and to use the Documentation to support such use.

2. **License Restrictions.** Subject to Section 8 regarding Tools, Customer may use the Software only during the applicable subscription term (“**Subscription Term**”) and only in combination with MariaDB products or services for which Customer holds an active subscription. Customer must not:

- (1) transfer, assign, resell, distribute, rent, lease, lend, or sublicense its rights (any attempt to do so is void),
- (2) use the Software with any MariaDB products or services for which it has no active subscription,
- (3) use the Software exceeding any limitations (e.g., quantities) prescribed by or agreed with MariaDB,
- (4) use the Software to perform services for third parties (e.g., managed services, hosting, time-sharing, or service bureau operations) without the express written authorization of MariaDB,
- (5) use the Software to develop competing products or services,
- (6) use the Software in any hazardous environment requiring fail-safe performance where failure could directly cause death, personal injury, or severe physical or environmental damage,
- (7) remove, conceal, or alter any proprietary or intellectual property notices in the Software or Documentation,
- (8) copy, decrypt, decompile, reverse engineer, disassemble, reduce to human-readable form, derive, or attempt to derive the source code, algorithms, or methods of the Software or its updates, except as expressly required by applicable law,
- (9) modify, adapt, or create derivative works of the Software or its updates, or
- (10) assist or encourage any third party to do any of the above.

3. **Proprietary Rights and Notices.** MariaDB retains all worldwide rights, title, and interest (including intellectual property rights) in the Software and Documentation. The Software is MariaDB’s trade secret and confidential information unless MariaDB makes it publicly available without confidentiality obligations. Customer acquires no rights beyond those expressly granted in these Terms. Customer must reproduce all original copyright and proprietary notices on any copies of the Software.

4. **Audit and Unauthorized Use.** Customer’s use of the Software is subject to the Agreement’s audit provisions. Unauthorized use of the Software is a material breach of these Terms. Upon notice, Customer must promptly pay for any unauthorized use at MariaDB’s then-current list prices. A breach of the license restrictions causes irreparable harm to MariaDB, entitling it to seek immediate injunctive relief alongside other available remedies.

5. **Benchmarks.** Customer must obtain MariaDB’s prior written approval before disclosing any Software benchmark, comparative test, or evaluation (“**Benchmark**”) to a third party. Any approved Benchmark disclosure

must include a complete and accurate description of the testing environment and methodology, as stipulated by MariaDB.

6. Term and Termination. Upon termination or expiration of the Subscription Term, Customer must immediately stop using and, within ten (10) business days, destroy all copies of the Software and Documentation in its possession or control. Customer may retain routine system backups if they are removed from live systems and remain subject to the confidentiality obligations. If requested, Customer must certify this destruction in writing to MariaDB. All restrictions, warranty disclaimers, and liability limitations survive termination of these Terms.

7. Miscellaneous. These Terms do not alter the license terms of any free and open-source software (FOSS) or software subject to the Business Source License (BSL). The Agreement prevails over these Terms in any conflict. If any part of these Terms is unenforceable, the remaining provisions stay in effect. Except as expressly stated, these Terms and the Agreement constitute the entire agreement between the parties regarding the Software and Documentation licenses.

8. Special Terms for Tools.

8.1 Precedence and Applicability. MariaDB may designate certain Software as tools, which are not trial software and do not require an active subscription ("**Tools**"). Regarding Tools and except for FOSS and BSL, this Section 8 prevails over any conflicting provisions in these Terms or the Agreement.

8.2 License Grant, Access and Restrictions. Customer may use the Tool for internal business purposes or for personal, non-commercial, and educational/academic purposes. Customer may allow its authorized contractors to use the Tool on Customer's behalf, provided Customer remains responsible for their compliance. MariaDB may provide the Tool in source, binary, or installation package form. If acting as or for a MariaDB competitor, Customer must not use the Tool for competitive benchmarking, analysis, or intelligence gathering. Customer must comply with all import and export laws and not export the Tool to embargoed countries or sanctioned parties.

8.3 DISCLAIMERS AND EXCLUDED PROTECTIONS. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE TOOL IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT ANY WARRANTIES. MARIADB DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THAT THE TOOL WILL OPERATE UNINTERRUPTED OR THAT DATA WILL NOT BE LOST, DELAYED, OR CORRUPTED. THE TOOL IS EXCLUDED FROM MARIADB'S SUPPORT POLICY; MARIADB WILL NOT PROVIDE SUPPORT, MAINTENANCE, BUG FIXES, OR SLAS. CUSTOMER ASSUMES ALL RISK OF USE AND MUST MAINTAIN RESTORABLE BACKUPS OF ALL DATA BEFORE USE.

8.4 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY CONFLICTING AGREEMENT TERMS, AND TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, MARIADB'S MAXIMUM AGGREGATE LIABILITY REGARDING THE TOOL IS \$5.00. MARIADB AND ITS AFFILIATES ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, OR FOR LOST PROFITS, REVENUE, DATA, OR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION. CUSTOMER MUST DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY MARIADB AND ITS AFFILIATES AGAINST ANY THIRD-PARTY CLAIMS OR COSTS ARISING FROM CUSTOMER'S USE OF THE TOOL, INCLUDING UNAUTHORIZED DATA ACCESS, MIGRATION, OR EXPORT VIOLATIONS.

8.5 Telemetry, Configuration Data, Third-Party Components, and Feedback. Customer consents to the Tool automatically collecting and transmitting diagnostic and usage telemetry to MariaDB, superseding any conflicting Agreement terms. Customer must not include confidential or personal information in open configuration fields or resource identifiers. The Tool may contain third-party components subject to separate licenses. Customer irrevocably assigns to MariaDB all rights in any Tool-related feedback.

8.6 Revocation and Termination. MariaDB may modify, limit, or revoke the Tool license or access at any time, without notice. Upon termination or revocation, Customer must immediately stop using the Tool and destroy all copies in its possession or control.
